Pop Star Art

Age 10-12 years

What you will need:

- A3/A4 black & white print of your favourite pop star or celebrity (please note that Artist's paper is better quality, so it may be worth photocopying the image onto a sheet of this)
- Pot of poster paints (variety of bright colours & black - blue, pink, yellow, orange)
- Paint brush for each colour



How to make your Pop Start Art:

This idea is inspired by Andy Warhol who was a famous artist known for his 'Pop Art' paintings. 'Pop Art' is a style of art that takes its inspiration from popular and commercial culture e.g. comics, films and advertising, as it uses very bright colours. You might recognise Andy Warhol's famous painting of Marilyn Monroe, which used lots of different bright colours and variations.

Step 1: Print out or photocopy of your favourite pop star, film star or TV character in black and white on either A3 or A4 size paper. It is best to use Artist's paper as you will be painting over the black and white print

Step 2: Paint the background of the picture with one bold, bright colour

Step 3: Now paint the dark sections on the picture with the black poster paint

Step 4: Paint every other section of the print with different bright colours, e.g. pink for the face, green for the lips, yellow for the hair. However, you can choose any colours which suit your liking

Step 5: It can be quite fun to print out 4 of the same picture and stick them onto one large page. Paint each individual print a different variation of colours. You might like your art so much, that you will want to frame it and hang it up in your bedroom!

If you are feeling extra creative, why not use a picture of your mum or dad, sister, friend or dog and create the image as above. These can make fantastic pressies for birthdays or Christmas.
